IF YOU'RE CURIOUS ABOUT HOW TO START THIS LANGUAGE JOURNEY, THIS GUIDE WILL WALK YOU THROUGH PRACTICAL STEPS, USEFUL RESOURCES, AND CULTURAL INSIGHTS TO MAKE YOUR LEARNING EXPERIENCE ENJOYABLE AND EFFECTIVE.

UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS OF DARI LANGUAGE

BEFORE DIVING INTO LEARNING TECHNIQUES, IT'S ESSENTIAL TO GRASP WHAT DARI IS AND HOW IT FITS INTO THE BROADER LINGUISTIC LANDSCAPE. DARI, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS AFGHAN PERSIAN, SHARES MANY SIMILARITIES WITH FARSI (SPOKEN IN IRAN) AND TAJIK (SPOKEN IN TAJIKISTAN). HOWEVER, DARI HAS ITS UNIQUE PRONUNCIATION, VOCABULARY, AND EXPRESSIONS THAT REFLECT AFGHANISTAN'S RICH HISTORY AND ETHNIC DIVERSITY.

WHAT MAKES DARI UNIQUE?

DARI USES THE PERSIAN ALPHABET, WHICH IS WRITTEN RIGHT TO LEFT AND CONSISTS OF 32 LETTERS. WHILE THE SCRIPT IS FAMILIAR TO THOSE WHO KNOW ARABIC, DARI INCLUDES ADDITIONAL LETTERS TO ACCOMMODATE SOUNDS SPECIFIC TO PERSIAN. THE LANGUAGE IS KNOWN FOR ITS POETIC NATURE AND FORMAL POLITENESS, WHICH IS EMBEDDED IN EVERYDAY SPEECH.

ONE OF THE CHALLENGES LEARNERS FACE IS MASTERING DARI'S PRONUNCIATION SINCE IT INCLUDES SOUNDS THAT MIGHT NOT EXIST IN OTHER LANGUAGES. HOWEVER, UNDERSTANDING BASIC GRAMMAR, SENTENCE STRUCTURE, AND COMMON PHRASES CAN QUICKLY BUILD A SOLID FOUNDATION.

EFFECTIVE STRATEGIES ON HOW TO LEARN DARI LANGUAGE

LEARNING ANY LANGUAGE REQUIRES A COMBINATION OF CONSISTENT PRACTICE, EXPOSURE, AND MOTIVATION. DARI IS NO DIFFERENT, AND BY TAILORING YOUR APPROACH, YOU CAN ACCELERATE YOUR PROGRESS.

START WITH THE ALPHABET AND PRONUNCIATION

SINCE DARI USES A SCRIPT THAT MIGHT BE UNFAMILIAR, BEGINNING WITH THE ALPHABET IS CRUCIAL. FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH EACH LETTER, ITS SOUND, AND HOW IT CONNECTS WITH OTHERS IN WORDS. MANY ONLINE PLATFORMS OFFER INTERACTIVE LESSONS TO PRACTICE READING AND WRITING DARI SCRIPT.

LISTENING TO NATIVE SPEAKERS PRONOUNCING LETTERS AND WORDS WILL HELP YOU INTERNALIZE THE SOUNDS. APPS LIKE YOUTUBE OR LANGUAGE LEARNING WEBSITES OFTEN HAVE PRONUNCIATION GUIDES, WHICH ARE INVALUABLE FOR BEGINNERS.

BUILD CORE VOCABULARY AND EVERYDAY PHRASES

FOCUSING ON HIGH-FREQUENCY WORDS AND PRACTICAL PHRASES ALLOWS YOU TO COMMUNICATE BASIC IDEAS EARLY ON. WORDS RELATED TO GREETINGS, NUMBERS, DAYS OF THE WEEK, FOOD, AND COMMON OBJECTS FORM THE BACKBONE OF

EVERYDAY CONVERSATION.

FLASHCARDS, SPACED REPETITION SYSTEMS (SRS), AND LANGUAGE APPS CAN HELP REINFORCE VOCABULARY. ADDITIONALLY, TRY TO USE NEW WORDS IN SIMPLE SENTENCES TO BETTER RETAIN THEIR MEANINGS AND CONTEXT.

IMMERSE YOURSELF IN LISTENING AND SPEAKING

LANGUAGE ACQUISITION FLOURISHES WHEN YOU ENGAGE MULTIPLE SENSES. TO LEARN DARI EFFECTIVELY, IMMERSE YOURSELF IN LISTENING MATERIALS SUCH AS DARI NEWS BROADCASTS, MUSIC, PODCASTS, AND MOVIES. THIS EXPOSURE ENHANCES COMPREHENSION AND FAMILIARIZES YOU WITH NATURAL SPEECH PATTERNS.

FINDING LANGUAGE EXCHANGE PARTNERS OR TUTORS WHO SPEAK DARI CAN BOOST YOUR SPEAKING CONFIDENCE. PLATFORMS LIKE iTALKI OR TANDEM CONNECT LEARNERS WITH NATIVE SPEAKERS FOR CONVERSATION PRACTICE.

UTILIZING RESOURCES TAILORED FOR DARI LANGUAGE LEARNERS

HAVING THE RIGHT TOOLS CAN MAKE A SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCE IN YOUR LEARNING JOURNEY. DARI, BEING LESS COMMONLY TAUGHT THAN MANY OTHER LANGUAGES, MIGHT REQUIRE A BIT MORE EFFORT TO FIND QUALITY RESOURCES, BUT THERE ARE VALUABLE OPTIONS AVAILABLE.

BOOKS AND TEXTBOOKS

SEVERAL TEXTBOOKS DESIGNED FOR DARI LEARNERS INTRODUCE GRAMMAR AND VOCABULARY SYSTEMATICALLY. BOOKS LIKE “COMPLETE DARI” OR “COLLOQUIAL DARI” PROVIDE STRUCTURED LESSONS AND EXERCISES. SUPPLEMENTING TEXTBOOKS WITH DARI-ENGLISH DICTIONARIES CAN ALSO HELP CLARIFY MEANINGS AND IDIOMS.

ONLINE COURSES AND APPS

DIGITAL PLATFORMS HAVE REVOLUTIONIZED LANGUAGE LEARNING. WEBSITES OFFERING DARI LESSONS OFTEN INCLUDE INTERACTIVE EXERCISES, QUIZZES, AND MULTIMEDIA CONTENT. SOME APPS MAY FOCUS ON VOCABULARY BUILDING, WHILE OTHERS OFFER COMPREHENSIVE COURSES COVERING GRAMMAR AND CONVERSATION.

COMMUNITY AND CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT

ENGAGING WITH DARI-SPEAKING COMMUNITIES, EITHER LOCALLY OR ONLINE, ENRICHES YOUR UNDERSTANDING BEYOND LANGUAGE MECHANICS. PARTICIPATING IN CULTURAL EVENTS, WATCHING AFGHAN FILMS, OR READING DARI POETRY HELPS CONTEXTUALIZE THE LANGUAGE AND KEEPS MOTIVATION HIGH.

OVERCOMING COMMON CHALLENGES IN LEARNING DARI

LIKE ANY LANGUAGE, DARI HAS ITS HURDLES. UNDERSTANDING THESE CHALLENGES AND ADOPTING STRATEGIES TO OVERCOME THEM CAN SMOOTH YOUR LEARNING PATH.

DEALING WITH SCRIPT AND CALLIGRAPHY

THE PERSIAN SCRIPT USED IN DARI CAN SEEM INTIMIDATING DUE TO ITS CURSIVE NATURE AND UNFAMILIAR LETTER CONNECTIONS. REGULAR PRACTICE IN WRITING AND READING IS KEY HERE. START BY COPYING SIMPLE SENTENCES AND GRADUALLY PROGRESS TO MORE COMPLEX TEXTS.

MASTERING PRONUNCIATION NUANCES

CERTAIN DARI SOUNDS, SUCH AS GUTTURAL OR EMPHATIC CONSONANTS, MIGHT BE DIFFICULT TO PRONOUNCE INITIALLY. LISTENING REPEATEDLY AND MIMICKING NATIVE SPEAKERS HELPS. RECORDING YOURSELF AND COMPARING YOUR PRONUNCIATION TO NATIVE AUDIO CAN PINPOINT AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT.

UNDERSTANDING GRAMMAR AND SENTENCE STRUCTURE

DARI GRAMMAR SHARES MANY FEATURES WITH OTHER INDO-IRANIAN LANGUAGES BUT ALSO INCLUDES UNIQUE ASPECTS LIKE VERB CONJUGATIONS AND NOUN CASES. MAKE USE OF GRAMMAR GUIDES AND PRACTICE EXERCISES REGULARLY. BREAKING DOWN SENTENCES AND TRANSLATING THEM CAN CLARIFY GRAMMATICAL PATTERNS.

TIPS FOR STAYING MOTIVATED WHILE LEARNING DARI

LANGUAGE LEARNING IS A MARATHON, NOT A SPRINT. MAINTAINING ENTHUSIASM IS CRUCIAL, ESPECIALLY WHEN PROGRESS FEELS SLOW.

- SET REALISTIC GOALS: WHETHER IT'S LEARNING 10 NEW WORDS A DAY OR HOLDING A FIVE-MINUTE CONVERSATION, ACHIEVABLE MILESTONES KEEP YOU MOTIVATED.
- CELEBRATE SMALL VICTORIES: EVERY TIME YOU UNDERSTAND A SENTENCE OR SUCCESSFULLY WRITE A PARAGRAPH, ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR PROGRESS.
- CONNECT WITH THE CULTURE: EXPLORING AFGHAN MUSIC, CUISINE, OR HISTORY ADDS A LAYER OF ENJOYMENT TO YOUR STUDIES.
- MIX UP YOUR LEARNING METHODS: COMBINE READING, WRITING, SPEAKING, AND LISTENING ACTIVITIES TO KEEP THINGS FRESH.

EMBARKING ON THE JOURNEY OF HOW TO LEARN DARI LANGUAGE CAN BE INCREDIBLY REWARDING. IT OFFERS NOT JUST LINGUISTIC SKILLS BUT ALSO A DEEPER APPRECIATION OF A VIBRANT CULTURE WITH A RICH LITERARY HERITAGE. WITH PATIENCE, DEDICATION, AND THE RIGHT APPROACH, YOU'LL FIND YOURSELF GRADUALLY UNLOCKING THE BEAUTY OF DARI AND CONNECTING WITH ITS SPEAKERS IN MEANINGFUL WAYS.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE THE BEST RESOURCES TO START LEARNING DARI LANGUAGE?

SOME OF THE BEST RESOURCES TO START LEARNING DARI INCLUDE LANGUAGE APPS LIKE DROPS AND MANGO LANGUAGES, ONLINE COURSES SUCH AS THOSE OFFERED BY TRANSPARENT LANGUAGE, TEXTBOOKS LIKE "COMPLETE DARI" BY TEACH YOURSELF, AND YOUTUBE CHANNELS DEDICATED TO DARI LANGUAGE LESSONS.

HOW LONG DOES IT TYPICALLY TAKE TO BECOME FLUENT IN DARI?

THE TIME TO BECOME FLUENT IN DARI VARIES DEPENDING ON PRIOR LANGUAGE EXPERIENCE AND STUDY INTENSITY, BUT GENERALLY, IT TAKES ABOUT 1 TO 2 YEARS OF CONSISTENT STUDY AND PRACTICE TO ACHIEVE CONVERSATIONAL FLUENCY.

IS DARI SIMILAR TO PERSIAN (FARSI), AND CAN KNOWLEDGE OF PERSIAN HELP IN LEARNING DARI?

YES, DARI IS A VARIETY OF PERSIAN SPOKEN IN AFGHANISTAN AND SHARES MANY SIMILARITIES WITH FARSI. KNOWLEDGE OF PERSIAN CAN SIGNIFICANTLY HELP IN LEARNING DARI AS THEY SHARE GRAMMAR, VOCABULARY, AND SCRIPT, THOUGH SOME PRONUNCIATION AND VOCABULARY DIFFERENCES EXIST.

WHAT ARE EFFECTIVE METHODS TO PRACTICE SPEAKING DARI?

EFFECTIVE METHODS INCLUDE LANGUAGE EXCHANGE WITH NATIVE SPEAKERS, PRACTICING WITH TUTORS ONLINE VIA PLATFORMS LIKE iTALKI OR PREPLY, JOINING DARI LANGUAGE GROUPS, AND USING LANGUAGE SHADOWING TECHNIQUES TO IMPROVE PRONUNCIATION AND FLUENCY.

ARE THERE ANY DARI LANGUAGE LEARNING APPS RECOMMENDED FOR BEGINNERS?

YES, APPS LIKE DROPS, MANGO LANGUAGES, AND MEMRISE OFFER BEGINNER-FRIENDLY DARI LANGUAGE COURSES THAT FOCUS ON VOCABULARY AND BASIC GRAMMAR, MAKING THEM SUITABLE FOR NEW LEARNERS.

HOW IMPORTANT IS LEARNING THE DARI SCRIPT FOR LANGUAGE ACQUISITION?

LEARNING THE DARI SCRIPT, WHICH IS A VARIANT OF THE PERSIAN-ARABIC SCRIPT, IS VERY IMPORTANT AS IT ALLOWS LEARNERS TO READ AND WRITE IN DARI, ACCESS A WIDE RANGE OF AUTHENTIC MATERIALS, AND IMPROVE OVERALL LANGUAGE UNDERSTANDING.

CAN WATCHING AFGHAN MOVIES AND LISTENING TO DARI MUSIC HELP IN LEARNING THE LANGUAGE?

ABSOLUTELY. WATCHING AFGHAN MOVIES AND LISTENING TO DARI MUSIC IMMERSE LEARNERS IN THE LANGUAGE CONTEXT, IMPROVE LISTENING SKILLS, EXPOSE THEM TO CULTURAL NUANCES, AND MAKE LEARNING MORE ENGAGING AND ENJOYABLE.

WHAT ARE SOME COMMON CHALLENGES FACED WHEN LEARNING DARI AND HOW CAN THEY BE OVERCOME?

COMMON CHALLENGES INCLUDE MASTERING THE SCRIPT, PRONUNCIATION DIFFERENCES, AND LIMITED LEARNING MATERIALS. OVERCOMING THESE INVOLVES CONSISTENT PRACTICE, USING MULTIMEDIA RESOURCES, ENGAGING WITH NATIVE SPEAKERS, AND ENROLLING IN STRUCTURED COURSES.

IS IT NECESSARY TO LEARN DARI GRAMMAR RULES EARLY ON, OR CAN LEARNERS FOCUS ON VOCABULARY FIRST?

WHILE FOCUSING ON VOCABULARY CAN HELP BEGINNERS START COMMUNICATING QUICKLY, LEARNING BASIC DARI GRAMMAR EARLY ON IS IMPORTANT TO FORM CORRECT SENTENCES AND UNDERSTAND THE LANGUAGE STRUCTURE, WHICH LEADS TO MORE EFFECTIVE LEARNING IN THE LONG RUN.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

UNDERSTANDING THE DARI LANGUAGE: CONTEXT AND CHARACTERISTICS

BEFORE DIVING INTO METHODS FOR HOW TO LEARN DARI LANGUAGE, IT IS ESSENTIAL TO GRASP ITS LINGUISTIC AND CULTURAL CONTEXT. DARI BELONGS TO THE INDO-IRANIAN BRANCH OF THE INDO-EUROPEAN LANGUAGE FAMILY AND SHARES A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH FARSI SPOKEN IN IRAN AND TAJIK IN TAJIKISTAN. WHILE MUTUALLY INTELLIGIBLE TO A LARGE EXTENT WITH PERSIAN VARIANTS, DARI POSSESSES UNIQUE PHONETIC, LEXICAL, AND GRAMMATICAL FEATURES, INFLUENCED BY AFGHANISTAN'S DIVERSE ETHNIC TAPESTRY.

UNLIKE PASHTO, THE OTHER OFFICIAL LANGUAGE OF AFGHANISTAN, DARI IS OFTEN USED IN GOVERNMENT, MEDIA, EDUCATION, AND LITERATURE. APPROXIMATELY 50% OF AFGHANS SPEAK DARI AS THEIR FIRST LANGUAGE, WHILE MANY OTHERS USE IT AS A SECOND LANGUAGE. THIS WIDESPREAD USAGE MAKES DARI A PRACTICAL CHOICE FOR COMMUNICATION ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND AMONG AFGHAN DIASPORA COMMUNITIES WORLDWIDE.

KEY CHALLENGES IN LEARNING DARI

LEARNING DARI PRESENTS SPECIFIC CHALLENGES THAT CAN AFFECT THE APPROACH AND EXPECTATIONS OF LEARNERS.

SCRIPT AND PRONUNCIATION

DARI USES A MODIFIED PERSO-ARABIC SCRIPT, WRITTEN RIGHT TO LEFT, WHICH MAY POSE DIFFICULTIES FOR LEARNERS UNFAMILIAR WITH NON-LATIN ALPHABETS. THE SCRIPT CONTAINS SEVERAL LETTERS NOT PRONOUNCED IN THE SAME WAY AS IN ARABIC, AND CERTAIN VOWEL SOUNDS ARE REPRESENTED DIFFERENTLY COMPARED TO FARSI. MASTERING THE SCRIPT IS A FOUNDATIONAL STEP IN LEARNING DARI AND REQUIRES DEDICATION TO READING AND WRITING PRACTICE.

PRONUNCIATION TENDS TO VARY REGIONALLY, WITH DIFFERENCES IN VOWEL LENGTH AND CONSONANT ARTICULATION. FOR EXAMPLE, DARI TYPICALLY PRESERVES THE ORIGINAL PRONUNCIATION OF CERTAIN VOWELS THAT HAVE SHIFTED IN IRANIAN PERSIAN, MAKING IT SOMEWHAT CLOSER TO CLASSICAL PERSIAN.

GRAMMAR AND SYNTAX

DARI GRAMMAR IS RELATIVELY STRAIGHTFORWARD COMPARED TO SOME OTHER LANGUAGES BUT STILL DEMANDS ATTENTION TO VERB CONJUGATIONS, NOUN CASES, AND SYNTAX. WORD ORDER GENERALLY FOLLOWS A SUBJECT-OBJECT-VERB PATTERN, WHICH MIGHT BE UNFAMILIAR TO ENGLISH SPEAKERS. ADDITIONALLY, THE USE OF ENCLITIC PRONOUNS AND POSTPOSITIONAL PHRASES REQUIRES PRACTICE TO ACHIEVE FLUENCY.

LIMITED LEARNING RESOURCES

COMPARED TO WIDELY TAUGHT LANGUAGES LIKE SPANISH OR MANDARIN, DARI RESOURCES ARE LESS ABUNDANT. WHILE THERE ARE TEXTBOOKS, ONLINE COURSES, AND TUTORS AVAILABLE, THE SELECTION IS NARROWER, ESPECIALLY FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS. THIS SCARCITY NECESSITATES A STRATEGIC APPROACH TO RESOURCE GATHERING AND OFTEN THE INTEGRATION OF MULTIPLE LEARNING TOOLS.

EFFECTIVE STRATEGIES FOR HOW TO LEARN DARI LANGUAGE

APPROACHING DARI WITH A CLEAR PLAN CAN GREATLY ENHANCE THE LEARNING EXPERIENCE. HERE ARE SOME PROVEN STRATEGIES TAILORED TO DARI'S UNIQUE FEATURES.

IMMERSE YOURSELF IN THE LANGUAGE ENVIRONMENT

IMMERSION IS ONE OF THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAYS TO LEARN ANY LANGUAGE, AND DARI IS NO EXCEPTION. IF TRAVELING TO AFGHANISTAN OR REGIONS WITH DARI-SPEAKING POPULATIONS IS FEASIBLE, ENGAGING DIRECTLY WITH NATIVE SPEAKERS ACCELERATES COMPREHENSION AND SPEAKING SKILLS. FOR THOSE UNABLE TO TRAVEL, VIRTUAL IMMERSION THROUGH MEDIA CAN BE INVALUABLE.

LISTENING TO DARI RADIO BROADCASTS, WATCHING AFGHAN NEWS CHANNELS, OR CONSUMING DARI FILMS AND MUSIC HELPS ATTUNE THE EAR TO NATURAL SPEECH PATTERNS AND VOCABULARY. PLATFORMS LIKE YOUTUBE AND PODCASTS FOCUSED ON AFGHAN CULTURE OFFER ACCESSIBLE CONTENT FOR LEARNERS AT VARIOUS LEVELS.

UTILIZE STRUCTURED LEARNING MATERIALS

STRUCTURED COURSES PROVIDE A NECESSARY FRAMEWORK, ESPECIALLY FOR BEGINNERS. POPULAR TEXTBOOKS SUCH AS "DARI: AN ELEMENTARY TEXTBOOK" BY RAHMAN ARMAN AND "COMPLETE DARI" BY TEACH YOURSELF SERIES SERVE AS SOLID STARTING POINTS. THESE MATERIALS TYPICALLY COVER ALPHABETS, GRAMMAR, VOCABULARY, AND EXERCISES TO REINFORCE LEARNING.

ONLINE PLATFORMS LIKE TRANSPARENT LANGUAGE AND LIVING LANGUAGE OFFER DARI COURSES THAT COMBINE AUDIO, VISUAL, AND INTERACTIVE ELEMENTS. ADDITIONALLY, SOME UNIVERSITIES WITH MIDDLE EASTERN OR CENTRAL ASIAN STUDIES PROGRAMS PROVIDE ONLINE DARI CLASSES WHICH CAN BE AUDITED OR ENROLLED IN FORMALLY.

PRACTICE SPEAKING WITH NATIVE SPEAKERS

LANGUAGE PRACTICE THROUGH CONVERSATION IS CRITICAL TO INTERNALIZING VOCABULARY AND GRAMMAR. LANGUAGE EXCHANGE WEBSITES SUCH AS TANDEM, HELLO TALK, OR SPEAKY CONNECT LEARNERS WITH NATIVE DARI SPEAKERS INTERESTED IN LANGUAGE EXCHANGE. ENGAGING IN REGULAR CONVERSATIONS, EVEN AT A BASIC LEVEL, BUILDS CONFIDENCE AND PRACTICAL COMMUNICATION SKILLS.

These dimensions are based on the work of the well-known Dutch anthropologist Geert Hofstede. The manifestations of these cultural dimensions explain the attitudes and actions of Afghans. Each chapter on dimensions also includes a section where the implications of a particular dimension are pointed out to the Westerner working in Afghanistan. Power Distance, the first dimension of culture, describes the relationship between a less powerful person and a more powerful one. As Afghanistan is on the high side of PD, social power is coercive in Afghanistan. One comes to power by force and is ousted by force; wealth and power are inseparable; decision making is autocratic and consultative; expert power does not carry much weight; age and charisma are important; and in Afghanistan, it is the authority of the person rather than the authority of position or rule that counts most. Uncertainty avoidance, the second dimension, involves dealing with fear and ambiguity—fear of nature, fear of other men, and fear of the supernatural. UA is negatively related to PD. A high PD society is on the low side of UA. Cultures use three methods to deal with fear and ambiguity: law, technology, and religion. Being on the low side of UA, Afghans rely heavily on Islam to reduce fear and uncertainty because they cannot rely on technology or the rule of law. The fundamental religious beliefs that help Afghans cope with fear and uncertainty are (1) life in this world temporary, (2) the source of both good and evil is God, and (3) God is just and will punish the oppressors and evil-doers in this world and in the next. Individualism versus collectivism, the third dimension of culture, relates to the relationship of an individual to a

collectivity. In nonindividualistic societies such as Afghanistan, one's loyalty and devotion is first and foremost to the family, ethnic or other collectivity, rather than to the country as a whole. Such loyalties are characteristic of nonnation-states, and are best explained as "Afghan nationalism" that is based on ethnicity, sect, region, and ideology. Afghanistan is not and has never been a nation-state. In a nation-state, people rally around the constitution, the flag, the national anthem, and other such symbols instead of their ethnicity, sect, region, ideology, and so on. Furthermore, a nation-state is based on the rule of law, checks and balances, human rights, freedom of the press, political parties, free and fair elections, accountability, and transparency. The concept of a nation-state is a Western phenomenon, although the roots of a nation-state are deep in some Islamic countries, shallow in others, and nonexistent in others. Turkey, the first Islamic country to have become a nation-state, falls into the first category whereas Afghanistan, into the last. For Afghanistan to move in the direction of becoming a nation-state, some type of federalism may be the only way to prevent further ethnic conflict and another civil war. Masculinity, the fourth dimension of culture, describes the degree to which there is a gender gap within a culture. Afghanistan is on the high side of MAS. As such, sex roles are set in the family and are reinforced in the schools, workplace, and other social organizations. In general, males are taught to be assertive and females, nurturing. In Afghan society, male assertiveness generally involves aggressiveness, bravery, endurance, leadership, power, dominance, and independence. Female nurturance, on the other hand, is characterized by submissiveness, patience, tenderness, and affection. It is Islamic fundamentalism and Afghan cultural tradition, rather than mainstream Islam, that limits the rights
