1. SET UP THE TRIPOD AND INSTRUMENT

THE PERSON HOLDING THE LEVELING STAFF SHOULD KEEP IT VERTICAL AND STEADY ON THE POINT OF INTEREST. THROUGH THE TELESCOPE, READ THE VALUE ON THE STAFF WHERE THE HORIZONTAL CROSSHAIR INTERSECTS.

THIS NUMBER REPRESENTS THE HEIGHT RELATIVE TO THE INSTRUMENT'S HORIZONTAL LINE OF SIGHT. TYPICALLY, YOU'LL TAKE READINGS AT MULTIPLE POINTS TO DETERMINE DIFFERENCES IN ELEVATION.

5. RECORDING AND CALCULATING HEIGHT DIFFERENCES

WRITE DOWN THE STAFF READINGS CAREFULLY. BY COMPARING THESE VALUES, YOU CAN CALCULATE THE HEIGHT DIFFERENCE BETWEEN VARIOUS POINTS ON YOUR SITE. THIS PROCESS IS FUNDAMENTAL IN TASKS SUCH AS GRADING OR ESTABLISHING FOUNDATIONS.
