THIS BALANCE BETWEEN HOPEFUL ASPIRATION AND HONEST REALISM SETS *OH THE PLACES YOU’LL GO* POEM BY DR SEUSS APART FROM MORE ONE-DIMENSIONAL MOTIVATIONAL TEXTS. IT VALIDATES THE READER’S FEARS AND CHALLENGES WHILE SIMULTANEOUSLY ENCOURAGING PERSEVERANCE.

LITERARY STYLE AND STRUCTURE
