WHY ARE THEY CALLED "MAJOR"?

ISAIAH: THE PROPHET OF SALVATION AND JUDGMENT

TRADITIONALLY ATTRIBUTED TO THE PROPHET ISAIAH BEN AMOZ, THIS TEXT IS OFTEN DIVIDED INTO THREE SECTIONS (PROTO-ISAIAH, DEUTERO-ISAIAH, AND TRITO-ISAIAH), SPANNING FROM THE 8TH CENTURY BCE THROUGH THE BABYLONIAN EXILE AND BEYOND. ISAIAH’S MESSAGES ARE MARKED BY A DUAL EMPHASIS ON IMPENDING JUDGMENT AGAINST ISRAEL AND SURROUNDING NATIONS, ALONGSIDE THE PROMISE OF A COMING MESSIAH AND SALVATION.

THE PROPHET’S USE OF VIVID IMAGERY AND POETIC LANGUAGE SETS ISAIAH APART. HIS VISION OF A SUFFERING SERVANT WHO WILL REDEEM HUMANITY HAS HAD A PROFOUND INFLUENCE ON BOTH JEWISH AND CHRISTIAN THOUGHT. FURTHERMORE, ISAIAH’S POLITICAL PROPHECIES REFLECT THE COMPLEX GEOPOLITICAL TENSIONS INVOLVING ASSYRIA, BABYLON, AND EGYPT DURING HIS LIFETIME.

JEREMIAH: THE WEeping PROPHET AND HIS LAMENTATIONS

JEREMIAH’S MINISTRY, LASTING FROM APPROXIMATELY 627 TO 586 BCE, COINCIDED WITH THE DECLINE OF JUDAH AND THE EVENTUAL DESTRUCTION OF JERUSALEM BY BABYLON. HIS PROPHECIES ARE CHARACTERIZED BY INTENSE EMOTIONAL APPEAL AND A DEEP SENSE OF PERSONAL ANGUISH, EARNING HIM THE MONIKER “THE WEeping PROPHET.” JEREMIAH’S BOOK COMBINES WARNINGS OF JUDGMENT WITH PROMISES OF A NEW COVENANT, EMPHASIZING THE INTERNAL TRANSFORMATION OF THE HEART OVER MERE RITUAL OBSERVANCE.

UNIQUELY, JEREMIAH ALSO AUTHORED THE BOOK OF LAMENTATIONS, A POETIC REFLECTION ON THE DEVASTATION OF JERUSALEM. HIS NARRATIVE PROVIDES INVALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO THE PSYCHOLOGICAL AND SPIRITUAL IMPACT OF EXILE ON THE JEWISH PEOPLE. JEREMIAH’S ROLE AS BOTH PROPHET AND PRIEST ADDS LAYERS OF COMPLEXITY TO HIS MESSAGE, HIGHLIGHTING TENSIONS BETWEEN DIVINE JUSTICE AND MERCY.

DANIEL’S NARRATIVES COMBINE COURT TALES WITH APOCALYPTIC VISIONS, SET AGAINST THE BACKDROP OF BABYLONIAN AND PERSIAN EMPIRES. THE BOOK IS DIVIDED INTO TWO DISTINCT PARTS: HISTORICAL STORIES THAT

DEMONSTRATE GOD’S SOVEREIGNTY IN FOREIGN COURTS AND PROPHETIC VISIONS FORECASTING FUTURE KINGDOMS AND DIVINE INTERVENTION.

DANIEL’S APOCALYPTIC LITERATURE HAS HAD A LASTING IMPACT ON ESCHATOLOGICAL STUDIES. RELEVANCE OF THE MAJOR PROPHETS TODAY

IN CONTEMPORARY RELIGIOUS STUDIES AND FAITH COMMUNITIES, THE MAJOR PROPHETS CONTINUE TO OFFER VALUABLE PERSPECTIVES ON JUSTICE, LEADERSHIP, AND SPIRITUALITY. THEIR EMPHASIS ON SOCIAL ETHICS, DIVINE ACCOUNTABILITY, AND HOPE AMID ADVERSITY RESONATES ACROSS CULTURES AND EPOCHS.
