HER INFLUENCE IS ALSO EVIDENT IN SHAPING PRESERVATION LEGISLATION AND POLICIES THAT BETTER ACCOMMODATE THE NARRATIVES OF IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES. BY ADVOCATING FOR BROADER CRITERIA IN LANDMARK DESIGNATION PROCESSES, PORTER HAS HELPED MAKE PRESERVATION EFFORTS MORE INCLUSIVE AND REPRESENTATIVE OF AMERICA'S DIVERSE HERITAGE.
