ADDITIONALLY, THOSE SEEKING ACTION-DRIVEN NARRATIVES MIGHT PERCEIVE THE BOOK AS QUIET OR INTROSPECTIVE.

HOWEVER, THESE CHARACTERISTICS ARE OFTEN VIEWED AS STRENGTHS WITHIN LITERARY CIRCLES, EMPHASIZING INTERNAL GROWTH OVER EXTERNAL CONFLICT.
