THE RECURRING REFERENCES TO NATURE, SUCH AS THE NORFOLK COUNTRYSIDE AND THE BOAT SCENE, EVOKE THEMES OF FREEDOM AND ENTRAPMENT, CONTRASTING THE CHARACTERS' CONFINED LIVES WITH THE WIDER WORLD THEY CAN ONLY GLIMPSE. THESE SYMBOLIC ELEMENTS ENRICH THE READING EXPERIENCE AND INVITE MULTIPLE INTERPRETATIONS.
