WHAT DOES THE DARK NIGHT REPRESENT?

AT ITS CORE, THE DARK NIGHT OF THE SOUL IS A METAPHOR FOR A SPIRITUAL CRISIS. IT DESCRIBES A PERIOD WHEN A PERSON FEELS ABANDONED, LOST, AND DISCONNECTED FROM GOD OR THEIR SENSE OF PURPOSE. STAGES OF THE DARK NIGHT ACCORDING TO JOHN OF THE CROSS

WHY THE DARK NIGHT OF THE SOUL MATTERS TODAY
