UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS OF PROTEIN SYNTHESIS

IN TRANSLATION, RIBOSOMES READ THE mRNA SEQUENCE IN SETS OF THREE NUCLEOTIDES CALLED CODONS. EACH CODON CORRESPONDS TO A SPECIFIC AMINO ACID OR A STOP SIGNAL. TRANSFER RNA (tRNA) MOLECULES BRING THE APPROPRIATE AMINO ACIDS, WHICH ARE THEN LINKED TOGETHER TO FORM A PROTEIN.
