HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE CITIZENSHIP TEST

IT COVERS TOPICS RANGING FROM INDIGENOUS PEOPLES AND CANADIAN SYMBOLS TO THE POLITICAL SYSTEM AND KEY HISTORICAL EVENTS.

ANSWER: OBEYING THE LAW AND VOTING IN ELECTIONS.

2. **QUESTION:** WHAT ARE SOME RIGHTS GUARANTEED BY THE CANADIAN CHARTER OF RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS?

ANSWER: FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION, FREEDOM OF RELIGION, AND THE RIGHT TO EQUALITY.

3. **QUESTION:** WHO HAS THE RIGHT TO VOTE IN FEDERAL ELECTIONS?

ANSWER: CANADIAN CITIZENS WHO ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

SYMBOLS AND TRADITIONS

1. **QUESTION:** WHAT IS THE NATIONAL ANTHEM OF CANADA?

ANSWER: "O CANADA."

2. **QUESTION:** WHAT ARE THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGES OF CANADA?

ANSWER: ENGLISH AND FRENCH.

3. **QUESTION:** WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE MAPLE LEAF?

ANSWER: IT IS A SYMBOL OF CANADA AND APPEARS ON THE NATIONAL FLAG.

If you don't pass, don't worry. You'll have another chance to retake the test within a few months. It's a good idea to review the areas where you had difficulty and seek additional support if needed.

ONLINE AND IN-PERSON TESTS

Due to evolving circumstances, the citizenship test may sometimes be offered online or in person. Make sure to check the latest information from IRCC to know what to expect. Regardless of the format, the content remains consistent.

The actual test lasts for 30 minutes and contains 20 multiple-choice questions. Applicants for citizenship must answer at least 15 (75%) questions correctly to pass the test. All practice questionnaires have been made in English from CIC's "Discover Canada" booklet.
