He created and acted in *The Rutles* and has appeared in numerous films including *The Adventures of Baron Munchausen* and wrote the book, and co-wrote the lyrics, for the award-winning musical *Spamalot* (based on Monty Python & *The Holy Grail*). Educated at the University of Oxford, Terry Jones worked in theatre, and wrote revues and scripts for the BBC before becoming one of the creators of Monty Python.
