3. **FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS:** WORKSHEETS FOLLOWED BY ANSWER KEY REVIEWS HELP TEACHERS IDENTIFY AREAS WHERE STUDENTS STRUGGLE AND ADJUST INSTRUCTION ACCORDINGLY.

DESPITE THEIR BENEFITS, TISSUE WORKSHEET ANSWER KEYS ALSO PRESENT CHALLENGES:

- **OVERRELIANCE:** STUDENTS MIGHT BECOME DEPENDENT ON ANSWER KEYS, REDUCING CRITICAL THINKING AND PROBLEM-SOLVING EFFORTS.
- **MISUSE:** WITHOUT GUIDED INSTRUCTION, ANSWER KEYS MAY ENCOURAGE COPYING RATHER THAN COMPREHENSION.
- **VARIED DIFFICULTY LEVELS:** NOT ALL ANSWER KEYS CATER TO DIFFERENT LEARNING PACES OR STYLES, POTENTIALLY HINDERING DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION.

TO MITIGATE THESE ISSUES, EDUCATORS SHOULD ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO ATTEMPT WORKSHEETS INDEPENDENTLY BEFORE CONSULTING ANSWER KEYS AND INTEGRATE DISCUSSIONS THAT DEEPEN UNDERSTANDING BEYOND THE SURFACE-LEVEL ANSWERS.
