THESE TRENDS ARE SHAPING THE CONTENT AND DELIVERY METHODS OF 40 HOUR INTERPRETER TRAINING MN COURSES TO PREPARE INTERPRETERS FOR CONTEMPORARY DEMANDS.

NAVIGATING THE PATH TO BECOMING A CERTIFIED INTERPRETER IN MINNESOTA INVOLVES A CLEAR UNDERSTANDING OF THE 40 HOUR INTERPRETER TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AND THEIR IMPLICATIONS.
