WHO WAS DR. SEUSS?

THE STORY OF DR. SEUSS BEGINS WITH THEODOR SEUSS GEISEL, BORN ON MARCH 2, 1904, IN SPRINGFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS. THE EARLY INFLUENCES AND CAREER BEGINNINGS

BEFORE DR. SEUSS BECAME A HOUSEHOLD NAME, HE WORKED IN ADVERTISING AND POLITICAL CARTOONS, HONING HIS SKILLS AS AN ILLUSTRATOR AND WRITER. HIS EARLY WORKS REFLECTED A WITTY AND SATIRICAL STYLE, BUT IT WAS DURING THE 1930S AND 1940S THAT HE BEGAN TO FOCUS ON CHILDREN'S BOOKS. HIS FIRST MAJOR SUCCESS WAS "AND TO THINK THAT I SAW IT ON MULBERRY STREET," PUBLISHED IN 1937 AFTER MULTIPLE REJECTIONS. THIS BREAKTHROUGH MARKED THE BEGINNING OF A REMARKABLE JOURNEY THAT WOULD REVOLUTIONIZE CHILDREN'S LITERATURE.

THE UNIQUE STYLE OF DR. SEUSS
