GETTING STARTED WITH POLAROID NOW FILM

THE POLAROID NOW CAMERA USES I-TYPE AND 600 INSTANT FILM, BOTH DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY TO PRODUCE THAT ICONIC POLAROID LOOK WITH THE CLASSIC WHITE BORDER AND RICH COLORS. BEFORE YOU LOAD THE FILM, IT'S IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND THE BASICS OF THE FILM TYPE AND HOW IT INTERACTS WITH YOUR CAMERA.

UNDERSTANDING POLAROID NOW FILM TYPES

POLAROID NOW SUPPORTS TWO MAIN TYPES OF FILM:

- **I-TYPE FILM:** THIS IS POLAROID'S LATEST FILM FORMAT DESIGNED FOR NEWER CAMERAS LIKE THE POLAROID NOW. IT DOESN'T CONTAIN A BATTERY INSIDE THE PACK, SO THE CAMERA'S INTERNAL BATTERY POWERS THE FILM'S EJECTION AND DEVELOPMENT PROCESS.
- **600 FILM:** COMPATIBLE WITH OLDER POLAROID 600 CAMERAS AS WELL AS THE NOW, THIS FILM HAS A BUILT-IN BATTERY THAT POWERS THE CAMERA'S FUNCTIONS. IT'S GREAT IF YOU WANT A BIT MORE VERSATILITY, BUT KEEP IN MIND IT MAY BE LESS ECO-FRIENDLY DUE TO THE BATTERY INSIDE EACH PACK.

BOTH FILMS PRODUCE 3.1 x 3.1-INCH PHOTOS WITH A WHITE FRAME, BUT I-TYPE FILM IS GENERALLY RECOMMENDED FOR THE POLAROID NOW, AS IT'S OPTIMIZED FOR THIS CAMERA'S BATTERY SYSTEM.

HOW TO LOAD FILM INTO YOUR POLAROID NOW

LOADING FILM PROPERLY IS THE FIRST STEP TO GREAT INSTANT PHOTOS. FOLLOW THESE STEPS CAREFULLY TO AVOID JAMS OR WASTED SHOTS:

1. OPEN THE FILM DOOR BY PRESSING THE LATCH ON THE SIDE OF THE CAMERA.
2. TAKE YOUR NEW FILM PACK OUT OF ITS SEALED BOX AND PEEL OFF THE BLACK PROTECTIVE COVER CAREFULLY WITHOUT TOUCHING THE FILM SHEETS INSIDE.
3. INSERT THE FILM PACK WITH THE DARK SLIDE (THE BLACK PROTECTIVE SHEET) FACING UP AND THE METAL CONTACTS ALIGNED WITH THE CAMERA'S CONTACTS.
4. CLOSE THE FILM DOOR FIRMLY UNTIL IT CLICKS INTO PLACE.
5. TURN ON YOUR POLAROID NOW; THE CAMERA WILL AUTOMATICALLY EJECT THE DARK SLIDE, PREPARING THE FILM FOR

YOUR FIRST PHOTO.

MAKE SURE TO KEEP THE CAMERA STEADY DURING THIS PROCESS TO AVOID ANY MECHANICAL ISSUES.

MASTERING THE USE OF POLAROID NOW FILM

ONCE YOUR FILM IS LOADED, IT'S TIME TO EXPLORE HOW TO SHOOT AND CARE FOR YOUR INSTANT PHOTOS. THE POLAROID NOW OFFERS A SIMPLE YET EFFECTIVE SHOOTING EXPERIENCE WITH AUTOFOCUS AND A BUILT-IN FLASH, BUT THERE ARE A FEW NUANCES THAT CAN HELP YOU CAPTURE BETTER IMAGES.

BEST PRACTICES FOR TAKING PICTURES WITH POLAROID NOW FILM

- **LIGHTING IS KEY:** INSTANT FILM LOVES NATURAL LIGHT. TRY TO SHOOT IN BRIGHT, INDIRECT SUNLIGHT FOR VIBRANT COLORS AND SHARP DETAILS. IF INDOORS, USE THE BUILT-IN FLASH TO ELIMINATE SHADOWS AND BRIGHTEN YOUR SUBJECT.
- **FRAME YOUR SHOT CAREFULLY:** THE POLAROID NOW'S AUTOFOCUS HELPS, BUT REMEMBER THE FIXED LENS HAS A MINIMUM FOCUSING DISTANCE OF AROUND 2 FEET. FOR CLOSE-UPS, SWITCH TO THE CAMERA'S CLOSE-UP LENS ATTACHMENT IF AVAILABLE.
- **BE PATIENT WITH DEVELOPMENT:** AFTER THE PHOTO EJECTS, AVOID SHAKING IT! INSTANT FILM DEVELOPS BEST WHEN LEFT TO SIT UNDISTURBED IN A DARK, DRY PLACE FOR ABOUT 10-15 MINUTES. SHAKING OR BENDING THE PHOTO CAN CAUSE UNEVEN DEVELOPMENT OR DAMAGE.
- **USE THE DOUBLE EXPOSURE FEATURE:** THE POLAROID NOW LETS YOU CREATE ARTISTIC DOUBLE EXPOSURES BY NOT ADVANCING THE FILM AFTER THE FIRST SHOT AND TAKING ANOTHER PICTURE ON THE SAME FRAME. THIS IS A CREATIVE WAY TO EXPERIMENT WITH YOUR INSTANT PHOTOGRAPHY.

HANDLING AND STORING YOUR INSTANT PHOTOS

PROPER HANDLING AND STORAGE CAN PRESERVE THE BEAUTY OF YOUR POLAROID PHOTOS FOR YEARS TO COME:

- **KEEP PHOTOS OUT OF DIRECT SUNLIGHT:** PROLONGED EXPOSURE TO UV RAYS CAN FADE COLORS OVER TIME.
- **STORE IN A COOL, DRY PLACE:** HEAT AND HUMIDITY CAN ACCELERATE PHOTO DEGRADATION.
- **AVOID TOUCHING THE PHOTO SURFACE:** OILS FROM YOUR FINGERS CAN LEAVE MARKS OR SMUDGES; HOLD YOUR PHOTOS BY THE EDGES.
- **CONSIDER ARCHIVAL OPTIONS:** FOR VALUABLE SHOTS, USE ACID-FREE PHOTO ALBUMS OR FRAMES WITH UV PROTECTION.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES WITH POLAROID NOW FILM

EVEN WITH THE BEST CARE, SOMETIMES THINGS DON'T GO AS PLANNED. HERE ARE SOME COMMON PROBLEMS USERS FACE WITH THE POLAROID NOW FILM AND HOW TO FIX OR PREVENT THEM.

FILM NOT EJECTING OR JAMMING

IF THE FILM DOESN'T EJECT AFTER LOADING OR BECOMES STUCK, TRY THESE STEPS:

- MAKE SURE THE FILM PACK IS INSERTED CORRECTLY WITH THE METAL CONTACTS ALIGNED.
- CHECK THE BATTERY LEVEL OF YOUR POLAROID NOW, AS LOW POWER CAN AFFECT EJECTION. RECHARGE BEFORE TRYING AGAIN.
- GENTLY OPEN AND CLOSE THE FILM DOOR TO RESET THE MECHANISM.
- IF PROBLEMS PERSIST, TRY A NEW FILM PACK TO RULE OUT A FAULTY BATCH.

PHOTOS ARE UNDEREXPOSED OR OVEREXPOSED

INSTANT FILM EXPOSURE CAN BE TRICKY BECAUSE IT DEPENDS HEAVILY ON LIGHTING AND CAMERA SETTINGS:

- USE THE BRIGHTNESS ADJUSTMENT DIAL ON THE POLAROID NOW TO TWEAK EXPOSURE. DIAL IT TO “+” FOR DARKER SCENES AND “-” FOR VERY BRIGHT CONDITIONS.
- WHEN SHOOTING IN LOW LIGHT, USE THE FLASH TO PREVENT UNDEREXPOSED IMAGES.
- FOR OVERLY BRIGHT SCENES LIKE SNOW OR BEACH SHOTS, CONSIDER USING THE “-” EXPOSURE SETTING TO AVOID WASHED-OUT PICTURES.

UNEVEN DEVELOPMENT OR WHITE STREAKS

SOMETIMES, PHOTOS DEVELOP WITH BLOTCHES OR STREAKS. THIS COULD BE DUE TO:

- FILM BEING EXPOSED TO LIGHT IMMEDIATELY AFTER EJECTION—ALWAYS SHIELD THE PHOTO UNTIL THE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS COMPLETES.
- TEMPERATURE EXTREMES; INSTANT FILM DEVELOPS BEST BETWEEN 55°F AND 82°F (13°C TO 28°C).
- EXPIRED OR DAMAGED FILM PACKS; ALWAYS CHECK THE EXPIRATION DATE AND STORE UNOPENED FILM IN A COOL ENVIRONMENT.

TIPS TO ENHANCE YOUR POLAROID NOW FILM EXPERIENCE

CUSTOMIZE YOUR PHOTOS

USE MARKERS OR STICKERS ON THE WHITE BORDERS TO PERSONALIZE YOUR SHOTS. SOME PHOTOGRAPHERS LIKE TO WRITE DATES, CAPTIONS, OR DOODLE AROUND THE FRAME, ADDING A UNIQUE TOUCH TO EVERY PICTURE.

STORE EXTRA FILM PROPERLY

KEEP YOUR UNUSED FILM REFRIGERATED (BUT NOT FROZEN) TO PROLONG ITS SHELF LIFE. ALLOW IT TO REACH ROOM TEMPERATURE BEFORE LOADING INTO YOUR CAMERA TO PREVENT CONDENSATION ISSUES.

JOIN THE INSTANT PHOTOGRAPHY COMMUNITY

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I LOAD FILM INTO THE POLAROID NOW CAMERA?

TO LOAD FILM INTO THE POLAROID NOW, OPEN THE FILM DOOR AT THE BACK OF THE CAMERA BY PRESSING THE RELEASE BUTTON. INSERT A NEW FILM PACK WITH THE DARK SLIDE FACING UP AND THE SILVER SIDE FACING OUT. CLOSE THE DOOR, AND THE CAMERA WILL AUTOMATICALLY EJECT THE DARK SLIDE.

WHAT TYPE OF FILM IS COMPATIBLE WITH THE POLAROID NOW?

THE POLAROID NOW IS COMPATIBLE WITH I-TYPE AND 600 INSTANT FILM PACKS. BOTH TYPES WORK THE SAME, BUT I-TYPE FILM DOES NOT CONTAIN A BATTERY, WHILE 600 FILM PACKS DO.

How do I know if the film is loaded correctly in the Polaroid Now?

Once the film pack is inserted and the door is closed, the camera will eject a dark slide. If the dark slide ejects smoothly, the film is loaded correctly. If nothing happens or you see an error light, reload the film.

Can I reuse the film pack after taking all pictures?

No, once all the sheets in the film pack have been used, the film pack is empty and should be removed. Attempting to reuse an empty pack can damage the camera or cause problems.

How do I eject the dark slide in Polaroid Now film?

The dark slide is automatically ejected by the camera after loading a new film pack. Simply close the film door, and the camera will eject the dark slide to protect your first photo.

How should I store Polaroid Now film for best results?
