He also considers the potential perils of biotechnology, nanotechnology, and artificial intelligence, including such topics of current controversy as how AI will impact employment and the safety of autonomous cars, and After Life technology, which aims to virtually revive deceased individuals through a combination of their data and DNA. The culmination of six decades of research on artificial intelligence, *The Singularity Is Nearer* is Ray Kurzweil's crowning contribution to the story of this science and the revolution that is to come.

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
