SAMPLE QUESTION 1: ELIGIBILITY FOR PREMIUM ASSISTANCE

QUESTION: A 30-YEAR-OLD INDIVIDUAL EARNS \$35,000 ANNUALLY. ARE THEY ELIGIBLE FOR PREMIUM ASSISTANCE THROUGH COVERED CALIFORNIA?

ANSWER: YES. FOR 2024, PREMIUM ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY GENERALLY APPLIES TO INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WITH INCOME BETWEEN 138% AND 400% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL (FPL). SINCE \$35,000 FALLS WITHIN THIS RANGE FOR A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL, THEY QUALIFY FOR PREMIUM TAX CREDITS.

SAMPLE QUESTION 2: SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD TRIGGERS

QUESTION: WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS QUALIFIES A CONSUMER FOR A SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD?

- A. LOSING EMPLOYER-SPONSORED COVERAGE
- B. MOVING TO A NEW COUNTY
- C. GETTING MARRIED
- D. ALL OF THE ABOVE

ANSWER: D. ALL OF THE ABOVE ARE QUALIFYING LIFE EVENTS THAT TRIGGER A SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD.

SAMPLE QUESTION 3: UNDERSTANDING METAL TIERS

QUESTION: WHICH METAL TIER PLAN GENERALLY HAS THE LOWEST MONTHLY PREMIUM BUT THE HIGHEST OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS?

ANSWER: BRONZE. BRONZE PLANS HAVE LOWER PREMIUMS BUT HIGHER DEDUCTIBLES AND COPAYMENTS COMPARED TO SILVER OR GOLD PLANS.
