Good News Bad News Jokes: The Perfect Blend of Humor and Surprise

IF YOU'VE EVER FOUND YOURSELF CHUCKLING AT A STORY THAT STARTS WITH "GOOD NEWS" ONLY TO BE FOLLOWED BY AN IRONIC "BAD NEWS," YOU ALREADY APPRECIATE THE CHARM OF THIS COMEDIC STYLE. IN THIS ARTICLE, WE'LL EXPLORE WHAT MAKES GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES SO EFFECTIVE, SHARE SOME CLASSIC AND FRESH EXAMPLES, AND OFFER TIPS ON CRAFTING YOUR OWN TO BRIGHTEN UP ANY SOCIAL SETTING.

WHY GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES ARE SO POPULAR

AT THEIR CORE, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES TAP INTO A UNIVERSAL HUMAN EXPERIENCE: THE ROLLERCOASTER OF EMOTIONS WE OFTEN FEEL WHEN RECEIVING MIXED INFORMATION. LIFE IS RARELY JUST GOOD OR BAD—IT'S A MIX OF BOTH, AND THESE JOKES MIRROR THAT REALITY IN A HUMOROUS WAY.

THE PSYCHOLOGY BEHIND THE HUMOR

HUMOR OFTEN ARISES FROM SURPRISE AND INCONGRUITY. WHEN A GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE SETS UP AN EXPECTATION WITH A POSITIVE STATEMENT, LISTENERS ANTICIPATE A HAPPY ENDING. THE SUDDEN SHIFT TO BAD NEWS DISRUPTS THAT EXPECTATION, CREATING A COMEDIC TWIST. THIS UNEXPECTED TURN TRIGGERS LAUGHTER AS A RELEASE OF THE TENSION BUILT UP BY THE INITIAL OPTIMISM.

ADDITIONALLY, THESE JOKES OFTEN RELY ON RELATABILITY. MANY PEOPLE HAVE EXPERIENCED MOMENTS WHERE A BIT OF HOPE IS QUICKLY DASHED, MAKING THE HUMOR HIT CLOSE TO HOME WITHOUT FEELING MEAN-SPIRITED. THE BALANCE BETWEEN LIGHTHEARTEDNESS AND TRUTH IS WHAT KEEPS GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES BOTH FUNNY AND MEMORABLE.

VERSATILITY IN SOCIAL SETTINGS

ONE REASON THESE JOKES REMAIN EVERGREEN IS THEIR ADAPTABILITY. THEY WORK WELL IN CASUAL CONVERSATIONS, OFFICE BANTER, AND EVEN IN ICEBREAKER SCENARIOS. THEIR STRUCTURE IS SIMPLE ENOUGH THAT ANYONE CAN UNDERSTAND AND APPRECIATE THEM, REGARDLESS OF AGE OR BACKGROUND. PLUS, THE FORMAT INVITES CREATIVITY, ALLOWING PEOPLE TO TAILOR JOKES TO THEIR OWN EXPERIENCES OR CURRENT EVENTS.

CLASSIC EXAMPLES OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

TO GET A BETTER SENSE OF HOW THESE JOKES FUNCTION, LET'S LOOK AT SOME WELL-LOVED EXAMPLES. NOTICE HOW THE PUNCHLINES RELY ON THE ELEMENT OF SURPRISE WHILE MAINTAINING A LIGHT AND PLAYFUL TONE.

- **EXAMPLE 1:** "GOOD NEWS: I PASSED THE EXAM! BAD NEWS: I WAS THE ONLY ONE WHO TOOK IT."
- **EXAMPLE 2:** "GOOD NEWS: I FINALLY GOT A JOB. BAD NEWS: IT'S AT THE PLACE I WAS TRYING TO AVOID."

- **EXAMPLE 3:** "GOOD NEWS: THE DOCTOR SAID I'M PERFECTLY HEALTHY. BAD NEWS: I HAVE TO COME BACK NEXT WEEK FOR MORE TESTS."

THESE JOKES DEMONSTRATE HOW SIMPLE SETUPS CAN LEAD TO AMUSING CONTRADICTIONS. THE HUMOR ARISES FROM THE JUXTAPOSITION OF HOPE AND DISAPPOINTMENT, WHICH OFTEN MIRRORS REAL-LIFE SITUATIONS.

HOW TO CRAFT YOUR OWN GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

INTERESTED IN CREATING YOUR OWN GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES? IT'S EASIER THAN YOU MIGHT THINK. HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO GET YOUR CREATIVE JUICES FLOWING:

START WITH A RELATABLE SITUATION

THINK ABOUT EVERYDAY SCENARIOS WHERE OUTCOMES CAN BE MIXED. IT COULD BE RELATED TO WORK, SCHOOL, RELATIONSHIPS, OR EVEN MUNDANE ACTIVITIES LIKE COOKING OR TRAVELING. THE MORE RELATABLE YOUR SETUP, THE MORE LIKELY YOUR AUDIENCE WILL CONNECT WITH THE JOKE.

BALANCE THE GOOD AND THE BAD

THE KEY TO A SUCCESSFUL JOKE IS MAINTAINING A BELIEVABLE BALANCE. IF THE GOOD NEWS IS TOO FANTASTIC, THE BAD NEWS MIGHT FEEL TOO HARSH OR VICE VERSA. AIM FOR A CONTRAST THAT IS SURPRISING BUT STILL PLAUSIBLE.

KEEP IT CONCISE

GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES ARE MOST EFFECTIVE WHEN THEY ARE BRIEF AND PUNCHY. AVOID OVER-EXPLAINING OR ADDING UNNECESSARY DETAILS THAT DILUTE THE IMPACT. THE QUICKER THE FLIP, THE STRONGER THE LAUGH.

USE WORDPLAY AND IRONY

ADDING CLEVER WORDPLAY OR IRONIC TWISTS CAN ELEVATE YOUR JOKE. PUNS, DOUBLE MEANINGS, OR UNEXPECTED INTERPRETATIONS OF COMMON PHRASES WORK WELL IN THIS FORMAT.

EXAMPLES OF CREATIVE GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

TO INSPIRE YOUR OWN JOKES, HERE ARE SOME ORIGINAL EXAMPLES THAT BLEND WIT AND SURPRISE:

- GOOD NEWS: I FOUND A WALLET ON THE STREET. BAD NEWS: IT WAS MINE.
- GOOD NEWS: I'M GETTING A PROMOTION AT WORK. BAD NEWS: I HAVE TO TRAIN MY REPLACEMENT FIRST.
- GOOD NEWS: I'M GOING ON VACATION NEXT WEEK. BAD NEWS: IT'S ONLY FOR TWO HOURS.

THESE JOKES SHOW HOW EVERYDAY DISAPPOINTMENTS CAN BE TURNED INTO FUNNY MOMENTS WITH JUST A LITTLE CREATIVITY.

INCORPORATING GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES IN DAILY LIFE

ADDING HUMOR TO YOUR DAILY INTERACTIONS CAN LIGHTEN MOODS AND STRENGTHEN CONNECTIONS. GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES ARE A GREAT TOOL FOR THIS BECAUSE THEY INVITE ENGAGEMENT AND OFTEN PROMPT SHARED LAUGHTER.

AT WORK

USE THESE JOKES TO BREAK THE ICE DURING MEETINGS OR TO EASE TENSION AFTER A STRESSFUL DAY. FOR EXAMPLE, WHEN ANNOUNCING A PROJECT UPDATE, YOU MIGHT SAY, “GOOD NEWS: WE FINISHED THE PROJECT EARLY. BAD NEWS: WE HAVE TO REDO HALF OF IT.”

WITH FRIENDS AND FAMILY

SHARING THESE JOKES IN CASUAL CHATS CAN KEEP CONVERSATIONS FUN AND LIVELY. THEY ALSO PROVIDE A PLAYFUL WAY TO TALK ABOUT CHALLENGES, MAKING THEM FEEL LESS DAUNTING.

ONLINE AND SOCIAL MEDIA

GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES ARE PERFECT FOR SOCIAL MEDIA POSTS OR COMMENTS BECAUSE THEY ARE SHORT, SHAREABLE, AND RELATABLE. THEY CAN BRIGHTEN SOMEONE’S FEED AND ENCOURAGE INTERACTION.

THE ROLE OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES IN HUMOR AND COMMUNICATION

BEYOND JUST ENTERTAINMENT, THESE JOKES SERVE AS A SUBTLE FORM OF STORYTELLING THAT REFLECTS LIFE’S COMPLEXITIES. THEY TEACH US TO FIND HUMOR IN SETBACKS AND TO APPRECIATE THE UNEXPECTED TWISTS THAT MAKE LIFE INTERESTING. THROUGH LAUGHTER, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES FOSTER RESILIENCE AND A POSITIVE OUTLOOK.

MOREOVER, THEY ENHANCE COMMUNICATION BY ENCOURAGING LISTENERS TO PAY ATTENTION CLOSELY AND THINK CRITICALLY ABOUT THE MESSAGE. THIS DYNAMIC INTERACTION BETWEEN SPEAKER AND AUDIENCE IS WHAT MAKES THESE JOKES SO ENGAGING AND MEMORABLE.

WHETHER YOU’RE LOOKING TO LIGHTEN THE MOOD OR SIMPLY ENJOY A CLEVER TWIST ON EVERYDAY SITUATIONS, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES OFFER A TIMELESS SOURCE OF AMUSEMENT. THEY REMIND US THAT LIFE IS A MIX OF HIGHS AND LOWS—AND SOMETIMES, THE BEST WAY TO HANDLE THAT MIX IS TO LAUGH TOGETHER.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS A GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE?

A GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE IS A TYPE OF HUMOR THAT PRESENTS A SCENARIO WITH BOTH POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE OUTCOMES, OFTEN STARTING WITH THE GOOD NEWS FOLLOWED BY THE BAD NEWS FOR COMEDIC EFFECT.

WHY ARE GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES POPULAR?

THEY ARE POPULAR BECAUSE THEY PLAY ON THE CONTRAST BETWEEN OPTIMISM AND DISAPPOINTMENT, CREATING SURPRISE AND LAUGHTER THROUGH UNEXPECTED TWISTS.

CAN YOU GIVE ME AN EXAMPLE OF A GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE?

SURE! GOOD NEWS: YOU WON THE LOTTERY! BAD NEWS: THE PRIZE IS A LIFETIME SUPPLY OF SOCKS.

HOW DO GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES WORK?

THESE JOKES WORK BY SETTING UP AN EXPECTATION WITH GOOD NEWS AND THEN SUBVERTING IT WITH BAD NEWS, WHICH CREATES HUMOR THROUGH CONTRAST AND IRONY.

ARE GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES APPROPRIATE FOR ALL AUDIENCES?

GENERALLY, YES. THEY ARE USUALLY LIGHT-HEARTED AND SUITABLE FOR MOST AUDIENCES, BUT IT'S ALWAYS GOOD TO CONSIDER THE CONTEXT AND SENSITIVITY OF THE TOPIC.

CAN GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES BE USED IN STORYTELLING?

YES, THEY CAN ADD HUMOR AND ENGAGE THE AUDIENCE BY CREATING RELATABLE SITUATIONS THAT HAVE BOTH POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE TWISTS.

WHAT MAKES A GOOD GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE?

A GOOD JOKE IN THIS STYLE BALANCES THE GOOD AND BAD NEWS CLEVERLY, OFTEN WITH A SURPRISING OR WITTY BAD NEWS PUNCHLINE THAT CONTRASTS SHARPLY WITH THE GOOD NEWS.

ARE GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES A TYPE OF ONE-LINER?

YES, MANY GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES ARE CONCISE ONE-LINERS THAT DELIVER BOTH PIECES OF NEWS QUICKLY FOR MAXIMUM COMEDIC IMPACT.

CAN GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES BE USED IN PROFESSIONAL SETTINGS?

THEY CAN BE USED CAUTIOUSLY IN PROFESSIONAL SETTINGS TO LIGHTEN THE MOOD, BUT IT'S IMPORTANT TO ENSURE THE JOKE IS APPROPRIATE AND NOT OFFENSIVE.

HOW CAN I CREATE MY OWN GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKE?

START BY THINKING OF A POSITIVE SITUATION, THEN ADD A HUMOROUS OR IRONIC NEGATIVE TWIST THAT CONTRASTS WITH THE GOOD NEWS, ENSURING THE PUNCHLINE IS UNEXPECTED AND FUNNY.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

Good News Bad News Jokes: A Timeless Blend of Humor and Irony

GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES HAVE LONG OCCUPIED A UNIQUE SPACE IN THE REALM OF HUMOR, SKILFULLY COMBINING OPTIMISM WITH CYNICISM TO PROVOKE LAUGHTER THROUGH CONTRAST AND SURPRISE. CONFLICTING EMOTIONAL PACKAGES.

THE ANATOMY OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

AT THEIR CORE, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES RELY ON A TWO-PART NARRATIVE THAT JUXTAPOSES CONTRASTING PIECES OF INFORMATION. THIS STRUCTURE TYPICALLY BEGINS WITH THE “GOOD NEWS,” SETTING A HOPEFUL OR REASSURING TONE, WHICH IS THEN UNDERCUT OR COMPLICATED BY THE “BAD NEWS.” THE INTERPLAY BETWEEN THESE ELEMENTS GENERATES A COGNITIVE DISSONANCE THAT IS BOTH AMUSING AND RELATABLE.

THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THESE JOKES DEPENDS HEAVILY ON TIMING, PHRASING, AND THE ELEMENT OF SURPRISE. UNLIKE STRAIGHTFORWARD PUNCHLINES, THE HUMOR EMERGES FROM THE UNEXPECTED SHIFT IN MOOD OR PERSPECTIVE. THIS DUALITY NOT ONLY ENTERTAINS BUT ALSO MIRRORS EVERYDAY EXPERIENCES WHERE SITUATIONS RARELY REMAIN PURELY POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE.

PSYCHOLOGICAL APPEAL AND COGNITIVE PROCESSING

RESEARCH IN HUMOR THEORY SUGGESTS THAT JOKES INVOLVING INCONGRUITY AND RESOLUTION TEND TO BE MOST EFFECTIVE. GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES CAPITALIZE ON THIS BY PRESENTING AN INITIAL CONGRUENT SCENARIO (THE GOOD NEWS) AND THEN DISRUPTING IT WITH AN INCONGRUENT ELEMENT (THE BAD NEWS). THIS TRIGGERS A MENTAL “AHA” MOMENT, WHERE THE LISTENER RECONCILES THE CONTRADICTION, RESULTING IN AMUSEMENT.

MOREOVER, THESE JOKES TAP INTO THE HUMAN TENDENCY TO ANTICIPATE OUTCOMES. PEOPLE NATURALLY EXPECT GOOD NEWS TO BE FOLLOWED BY MORE GOOD NEWS OR AT LEAST NEUTRAL INFORMATION. THE SUDDEN INTRODUCTION OF BAD NEWS DEFIES THIS EXPECTATION, ENHANCING THE COMEDIC IMPACT. THIS MECHANISM ALIGNS WITH THE INCONGRUITY-RESOLUTION THEORY OF HUMOR, WHICH POSITS THAT HUMOR ARISES WHEN AN INCONGRUOUS SITUATION IS RESOLVED IN AN UNEXPECTED WAY.

VARIETIES AND EXAMPLES OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

THE GENRE OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES IS DIVERSE, RANGING FROM LIGHTHEARTED ONE-LINERS TO MORE ELABORATE ANECDOTES. HERE ARE SOME COMMON VARIATIONS:

- **CLASSIC FORMAT:** A CONCISE DELIVERY OF CONTRASTING NEWS, E.G., “GOOD NEWS: THE TEST WAS EASY. BAD NEWS: YOU STILL FAILED.”
- **SITUATIONAL HUMOR:** LONGER STORIES WHERE CIRCUMSTANCES SHIFT DRAMATICALLY, OFTEN INVOLVING PROFESSIONS LIKE DOCTORS, LAWYERS, OR ENGINEERS.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS WITH OTHER JOKE STRUCTURES

COMPARED TO TRADITIONAL SETUPS AND PUNCHLINES, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES OFFER A BALANCED DUALITY THAT CAN BE MORE ENGAGING DUE TO THEIR NARRATIVE COMPLEXITY. WHILE A STANDARD JOKE OFTEN ENDS WITH A SINGLE PUNCHLINE THAT

SUBVERTS EXPECTATIONS, THESE JOKES MAINTAIN A CONVERSATIONAL TONE, MAKING THEM VERSATILE FOR VARIOUS CONTEXTS—WHETHER CASUAL BANTER, STAND-UP COMEDY, OR WORKPLACE HUMOR.

ADDITIONALLY, THE FORMAT’S PREDICTABILITY IN STRUCTURE PARADOXICALLY ENHANCES ITS COMEDIC POTENTIAL. AUDIENCES ANTICIPATE THE “BAD NEWS” FOLLOWING THE “GOOD NEWS,” YET THE CONTENT OF THE BAD NEWS REMAINS UNPREDICTABLE, PRESERVING THE ELEMENT OF SURPRISE.

PROS AND CONS OF USING GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES

LIKE ANY FORM OF HUMOR, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES COME WITH ADVANTAGES AND LIMITATIONS, ESPECIALLY WHEN CONSIDERED FOR SOCIAL SETTINGS, MEDIA, OR EVEN DIGITAL CONTENT.

ADVANTAGES

- **RELATABILITY:** THE FORMAT MIRRORS REAL-LIFE EXPERIENCES OF MIXED OUTCOMES, MAKING THE JOKES WIDELY ACCESSIBLE.
- **VERSATILITY:** SUITABLE FOR DIVERSE AUDIENCES AND ADAPTABLE TO VARIOUS TOPICS, FROM WORK SCENARIOS TO PERSONAL ANECDOTES.
- **ENGAGEMENT:** THE DUAL NEWS STRUCTURE ENCOURAGES LISTENERS TO MENTALLY PARTICIPATE IN RECONCILING THE CONTRASTING INFORMATION.

LIMITATIONS

- **RISK OF NEGATIVITY:** IF NOT CRAFTED CAREFULLY, THE BAD NEWS COMPONENT MAY OVERSHADOW THE HUMOR AND FEEL PESSIMISTIC OR INSENSITIVE.
- **PREDICTABILITY:** FREQUENT USE WITHOUT INNOVATION CAN MAKE THE FORMAT FEEL STALE, AS AUDIENCES GROW ACCUSTOMED TO THE PATTERN.
- **CULTURAL SENSITIVITY:** SOME JOKES MAY NOT TRANSLATE WELL ACROSS CULTURES OR COULD INADVERTENTLY OFFEND IF THE BAD NEWS TOUCHES ON SENSITIVE TOPICS.

GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES IN THE DIGITAL AGE

DIGITAL ADAPTATIONS OFTEN INCORPORATE VISUAL ELEMENTS—SUCH AS IMAGES OR VIDEOS—THAT ENHANCE THE CONTRAST BETWEEN THE GOOD AND BAD NEWS, MAKING THE JOKE MORE IMPACTFUL. GIFS AND REACTION MEMES FREQUENTLY ACCOMPANY THESE JOKES TO EMPHASIZE THE EMOTIONAL SWINGS BETWEEN HOPE AND DISAPPOINTMENT.

FURTHERMORE, THE SHAREABILITY OF THESE JOKES CONTRIBUTES TO THEIR VIRAL POTENTIAL. USERS TEND TO ENGAGE WITH

CONTENT THAT REFLECTS THEIR OWN EXPERIENCES OF IRONY OR FRUSTRATION, MAKING GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES A POPULAR CHOICE FOR ONLINE HUMOR.

SEO IMPLICATIONS FOR CONTENT CREATORS

FOR WRITERS AND MARKETERS AIMING TO LEVERAGE GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES IN CONTENT, UNDERSTANDING RELEVANT KEYWORDS AND SEARCH INTENT IS CRUCIAL. INTEGRATING VARIATIONS LIKE “GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES EXAMPLES,” “BEST GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES,” OR “FUNNY GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS STORIES” CAN ENHANCE VISIBILITY.

ADDITIONALLY, INCORPORATING RELATED TERMS SUCH AS “IRONIC JOKES,” “CONTRAST HUMOR,” OR “TWO-PART JOKES” HELPS DIVERSIFY KEYWORD USAGE, ALIGNING WITH LSI (LATENT SEMANTIC INDEXING) PRINCIPLES. THIS APPROACH IMPROVES SEARCH ENGINE RANKINGS WHILE MAINTAINING NATURAL READABILITY.

CONTENT CREATORS SHOULD ALSO CONSIDER AUDIENCE DEMOGRAPHICS AND THE CONTEXT IN WHICH THESE JOKES APPEAR. FOR INSTANCE, WORKPLACE BLOGS MIGHT FAVOR LIGHTHEARTED, NON-OFFENSIVE EXAMPLES, WHEREAS COMEDY WEBSITES MAY EXPERIMENT WITH EDGIER VARIATIONS.

BEYOND THEIR ENTERTAINMENT VALUE, GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES REFLECT CULTURAL ATTITUDES TOWARD OPTIMISM AND ADVERSITY. IN MANY SOCIETIES, HUMOR SERVES AS A COPING MECHANISM, AND THESE JOKES ENCAPSULATE THE HUMAN EXPERIENCE OF NAVIGATING UNCERTAINTY AND MIXED FORTUNES.

THE FORMAT’S ABILITY TO CONVEY COMPLEX EMOTIONS SUCCINCTLY MAKES IT A VALUABLE TOOL IN SOCIAL COMMENTARY. BY HIGHLIGHTING THE COEXISTENCE OF POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE OUTCOMES, THE JOKES SUBTLY CRITIQUE EXPECTATIONS OF LINEAR PROGRESS OR CONSTANT POSITIVITY.

MOREOVER, THE RECEPTION OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES CAN VARY DEPENDING ON SOCIAL CONTEXT, CULTURAL NORMS, AND INDIVIDUAL SENSIBILITIES. WHAT IS CONSIDERED HUMOROUS IN ONE SETTING MIGHT BE PERCEIVED AS INSENSITIVE OR INAPPROPRIATE IN ANOTHER.

THIS VARIABILITY UNDERSCORES THE IMPORTANCE OF CONTEXT-AWARE HUMOR, ESPECIALLY IN GLOBALIZED COMMUNICATION CHANNELS WHERE AUDIENCES ARE DIVERSE.

THE ENDURING APPEAL OF GOOD NEWS BAD NEWS JOKES LIES IN THEIR ELEGANT SIMPLICITY AND PSYCHOLOGICAL RESONANCE. THEY INVITE AUDIENCES TO CONFRONT THE UNPREDICTABLE NATURE OF LIFE WITH A SMILE, REMINDING US THAT GOOD AND BAD OFTEN COME HAND-IN-HAND—SOMETIMES IN THE MOST UNEXPECTED WAYS.

Part III reviews the failed attempt to establish a viable socialist party in the United States. The real thrust toward socialism, originally launched by the New Deal of Roosevelt, came when Barak Obama, a thoroughly indoctrinated and dedicated socialist, ascended to the US presidency. This socialism is an attempt to expand income redistribution and social welfare policies and to pursue massive industrial regulation and unconstitutional interventions in the private sector. The implications of these policies are discussed together with the associated loss of market freedoms and personal liberties.
