TRADITIONAL FAIRY TALES LIKE "CINDERELLA," "SLEEPING BEAUTY," AND "HANSEL AND GRETEL" FIT THIS MOLD QUITE CLEARLY. THEY CONTAIN MAGICAL ELEMENTS AND OFTEN FEATURE FANTASTICAL CREATURES OR EVENTS.

## IS THREE LITTLE PIGS A FAIRY TALE OR A FABLE?

THE STORY OF THE THREE LITTLE PIGS CENTERS AROUND THREE SIBLINGS WHO EACH BUILD A HOUSE WITH DIFFERENT MATERIALS—STRAW, STICKS, AND BRICKS—TO PROTECT THEMSELVES FROM A WOLF WHO WANTS TO EAT THEM. THE WOLF HUFFS AND PUFFS, BLOWING DOWN THE FIRST TWO HOUSES, BUT FAILS TO DESTROY THE BRICK HOUSE.

## FAIRY TALE ELEMENTS IN THE THREE LITTLE PIGS

- THE WOLF IN THE STORY IS ANTHROPOMORPHIZED; IT TALKS AND PLOTS, WHICH IS COMMON IN FAIRY TALES.
- THE STORY CONVEYS A CLEAR MORAL: HARD WORK AND PREPARATION (BUILDING A STURDY HOUSE) LEAD TO SUCCESS AND SAFETY.
- THE NARRATIVE IS SIMPLE AND ARCHETYPAL: THE CLEVERNESS AND DILIGENCE OF THE THIRD PIG VERSUS THE WOLF'S BRUTE FORCE.
- THE SETTING IS VAGUE AND TIMELESS, CONSISTENT WITH MANY FAIRY TALES.

## WHY SOME ARGUE IT'S MORE OF A FABLE

FABLES ARE SHORT STORIES THAT TEACH A MORAL LESSON, USUALLY FEATURING ANIMALS WITH HUMAN QUALITIES. UNLIKE FAIRY TALES, FABLES RARELY INVOLVE MAGICAL EVENTS OR ENCHANTED CHARACTERS. THE THREE LITTLE PIGS SHARES SEVERAL TRAITS WITH FABLES:

- THE MAIN CHARACTERS ARE ANIMALS BEHAVING LIKE HUMANS.
- THE STORY'S PRIMARY PURPOSE IS TO TEACH A LESSON ABOUT HARD WORK AND PRUDENCE.

- IT LACKS MAGICAL OR SUPERNATURAL ELEMENTS BEYOND TALKING ANIMALS.

BECAUSE OF THESE TRAITS, MANY SCHOLARS CLASSIFY THE THREE LITTLE PIGS AS A FABLE RATHER THAN A TRADITIONAL FAIRY TALE.

## THE ORIGINS AND EVOLUTION OF THE THREE LITTLE PIGS STORY

TO UNDERSTAND ITS CLASSIFICATION BETTER, IT HELPS TO LOOK AT WHERE THE STORY CAME FROM. THE THREE LITTLE PIGS IS PART OF THE ORAL STORYTELLING TRADITION, WITH ROOTS TRACING BACK TO 18TH-CENTURY ENGLAND.
