Other than keynote opening statements, the special issue is comprised of a selected series of longer and shorter poems by Mahmoud Darwish, followed by commemorative poetry and essays/articles that directly or indirectly engage with Mahmoud Darwish's work and/or the subject matter of his passion and love, Palestine and human rights and dignity. The course was freshly designed and titled, "Soc 280Z: Sociology of Knowledge: Mysticism, Science, and Utopia." The class-book was designed and printed in less than two weeks by the instructor in order to make it available to students as soon as possible after the class. The "fake" publisher name proposed by a contributing student author (Ingrid Heller) and adopted by the contributors was the "Crumbling Façades Press." The class-book experiment was one that eventually inspired and contributed to the launching of *Human Architecture: Journal of the Sociology of Self-Knowledge* (ISSN: 1540-5699, 2002-).
