PATIENT ADHERENCE, OR COMPLIANCE, IS CRITICAL; NO DRUG CAN BE EFFECTIVE IF NOT TAKEN AS PRESCRIBED. THEREFORE, ENGAGING PATIENTS IN THEIR TREATMENT PLANS IMPROVES OUTCOMES SIGNIFICANTLY.

PHARMACOKINETICS AND PHARMACODYNAMICS: THE SCIENCE BEHIND DRUG ACTION

FOLLOW-UP APPOINTMENTS PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES TO REASSESS THERAPY AND MAKE NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS.

4. MINIMIZING DRUG INTERACTIONS AND ADVERSE EFFECTS

DRUG INTERACTIONS CAN COMPROMISE EFFICACY OR INCREASE TOXICITY. VIGILANCE ABOUT POTENTIAL INTERACTIONS—WHETHER PHARMACOKINETIC OR PHARMACODYNAMIC—IS VITAL. EDUCATING PATIENTS ABOUT POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS AND WHEN TO SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE FOSTERS SAFER MEDICATION USE.

CLINICAL APPLICATION AND PRACTICE OF PHARMACOTHERAPY
