ON THE OTHER HAND, MR. KIDSWATTER, THE PRINCIPAL, IS A CARICATURE OF AUTHORITARIANISM. HIS EXAGGERATED RULES AND ODD BEHAVIORS ADD A LAYER OF SATIRE TO THE SCHOOL'S ENVIRONMENT, OFTEN HIGHLIGHTING THE SILLINESS OF RIGID AUTHORITY.

STUDENTS WITH PERSONALITY

FROM TODD, THE PROTAGONIST WHO OFTEN FINDS HIMSELF IN STRANGE PREDICAMENTS, TO MAURECIA, WHO IS FEARLESS AND OUTSPOKEN, EACH STUDENT ADDS A UNIQUE FLAVOR TO THE STORIES. CHARACTERS LIKE MYRON, THE OVERACHIEVER, AND SAMMY, THE MISCHIEVOUS KID, MAKE THE SCHOOL FEEL LIKE A MICROCOSM OF A REAL CLASSROOM, ALBEIT A VERY UNUSUAL ONE.

THESE CHARACTERS' DIVERSE TRAITS ENCOURAGE READERS TO APPRECIATE DIFFERENCES AND UNDERSTAND THE VALUE OF FRIENDSHIP, COOPERATION, AND SOMETIMES JUST EMBRACING THE WEIRDNESS AROUND US.

WHY WAYSIDE STORIES FROM WAYSIDE SCHOOL RESONATE WITH READERS
