AN ELEMENT OF PRIVACY AND SECRECY

ANOTHER THEORY POSITS THAT THE BACKWARDS WRITING SERVED AS A FORM OF ENCRYPTION. LEONARDO'S NOTEBOOKS CONTAINED INNOVATIVE IDEAS ON ANATOMY, ENGINEERING, AND INVENTIONS THAT WERE AHEAD OF HIS TIME.
