WHY HOME VETERINARY CARE MATTERS

HOME VETERINARY CARE PROVIDES SEVERAL BENEFITS:

- ****EARLY DETECTION:**** SPOTTING SYMPTOMS LIKE CHANGES IN APPETITE, BEHAVIOR, OR GROOMING HABITS EARLY CAN DRASTICALLY IMPROVE TREATMENT OUTCOMES.
- ****COST-EFFECTIVE:**** MINOR ISSUES ADDRESSED AT HOME CAN REDUCE FREQUENT VET VISITS AND EMERGENCY COSTS.
- ****COMFORT FOR YOUR CAT:**** MANY CATS EXPERIENCE LESS STRESS WHEN TREATED IN FAMILIAR SURROUNDINGS.
- ****BOND STRENGTHENING:**** CARING FOR YOUR CAT'S HEALTH YOURSELF BUILDS TRUST AND DEEPENS YOUR BOND.

BASIC HEALTH CHECKS EVERY CAT OWNER SHOULD KNOW

ROUTINE AT-HOME HEALTH ASSESSMENTS FORM THE BACKBONE OF ANY CAT OWNERS HOME VETERINARY HANDBOOK. THESE SIMPLE CHECKS ALLOW YOU TO STAY IN TUNE WITH YOUR CAT'S NORMAL CONDITION AND SWIFTLY SPOT ABNORMALITIES.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

PERFORMING A GENTLE PHYSICAL EXAM ONCE A WEEK HELPS YOU MONITOR YOUR CAT'S HEALTH STATUS:

- ****EYES:**** CLEAR, BRIGHT, AND FREE FROM DISCHARGE.
- ****EARS:**** CLEAN INSIDE, WITHOUT REDNESS OR FOUL ODOR.
- ****MOUTH:**** PINK GUMS, NO BAD BREATH OR EXCESSIVE DROOLING.
- ****COAT:**** SHINY, SMOOTH, AND FREE OF BALD SPOTS OR EXCESSIVE DANDRUFF.
- ****SKIN:**** CHECK FOR LUMPS, BUMPS, OR SIGNS OF PARASITES LIKE FLEAS OR TICKS.

- **BODY CONDITION:** FEEL FOR ANY UNUSUAL LUMPS OR SWELLING.
- **WEIGHT:** MONITOR CHANGES; SUDDEN LOSS OR GAIN CAN INDICATE HEALTH ISSUES.

BEHAVIORAL OBSERVATIONS

CATS COMMUNICATE THEIR HEALTH THROUGH BEHAVIOR. KEEP AN EYE ON:

- CHANGES IN APPETITE OR WATER INTAKE.
- ALTERED LITTER BOX HABITS.
- INCREASED HIDING OR LETHARGY.
- UNUSUAL AGGRESSION OR VOCALIZATION.
- OVERGROOMING OR SCRATCHING.

DOCUMENTING THESE CHANGES CAN BE INVALUABLE WHEN YOU CONSULT YOUR VET.

COMMON FELINE AILMENTS AND HOME REMEDIES

WHILE SERIOUS CONDITIONS ALWAYS REQUIRE PROFESSIONAL CARE, MANY MINOR AILMENTS CAN BE MANAGED AT HOME IF YOU HAVE THE RIGHT KNOWLEDGE.

DIGESTIVE UPSET

CATS CAN SUFFER FROM OCCASIONAL VOMITING OR DIARRHEA DUE TO DIETARY INDISCRETION OR MILD INFECTIONS. IN THESE CASES:

- TEMPORARILY WITHHOLD FOOD FOR 12-24 HOURS TO ALLOW THE GUT TO REST.
- PROVIDE ACCESS TO FRESH WATER TO PREVENT DEHYDRATION.
- OFFER A BLAND DIET SUCH AS BOILED CHICKEN AND RICE ONCE FEEDING RESUMES.

IF SYMPTOMS PERSIST BEYOND 48 HOURS OR WORSEN, A VET VISIT IS ESSENTIAL.

MINOR WOUNDS AND SKIN ISSUES

SCRATCHES AND SMALL CUTS HAPPEN, ESPECIALLY IN OUTDOOR CATS. TO MANAGE THEM:

- CLEAN THE WOUND GENTLY WITH WARM WATER AND MILD ANTISEPTIC.
- APPLY A PET-SAFE ANTIBIOTIC OINTMENT.
- PREVENT YOUR CAT FROM LICKING THE WOUND TO AVOID INFECTION.

WATCH FOR REDNESS, SWELLING, OR DISCHARGE, WHICH COULD INDICATE INFECTION REQUIRING VETERINARY ATTENTION.

FLEAS AND PARASITES

FLEAS ARE A COMMON NUISANCE AND CAN LEAD TO SKIN IRRITATION OR MORE SEVERE CONDITIONS LIKE ANEMIA. HOME CARE INCLUDES:

- REGULARLY BRUSHING YOUR CAT TO SPOT FLEAS OR FLEA DIRT.
- BATHING WITH A VET-APPROVED FLEA SHAMPOO IF NECESSARY.

- USING FLEA PREVENTION PRODUCTS MONTHLY AS RECOMMENDED BY YOUR VETERINARIAN.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FOR CAT OWNERS

- DIGITAL THERMOMETER.
- HYDROGEN PEROXIDE (TO INDUCE VOMITING ONLY IF ADVISED BY A VET).
- EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS.

RECOGNIZING WARNING SIGNS

SEEK IMMEDIATE VETERINARY CARE IF YOUR CAT EXHIBITS:

- DIFFICULTY BREATHING OR PERSISTENT COUGHING.
- SEIZURES OR COLLAPSE.
- SEVERE BLEEDING OR TRAUMA.
- SUDDEN PARALYSIS OR INABILITY TO MOVE.
- SIGNS OF POISONING (DROOLING, VOMITING, TREMORS).

HAVING A PLAN FOR QUICK TRANSPORTATION AND KNOWING THE LOCATION OF THE NEAREST 24/7 EMERGENCY CLINIC IS CRUCIAL.

NUTRITION AND PREVENTIVE CARE AT HOME
