HIS ABILITY TO MAINTAIN HIS MALE PERSONA THROUGHOUT HIS EDUCATION AND SUBSEQUENT MILITARY CAREER UNDERSCORES BOTH HIS DETERMINATION AND THE SOCIETAL LIMITATIONS FACED BY WOMEN IN PROFESSIONAL FIELDS.

BREAKING BARRIERS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF EDINBURGH

BARRY'S ACADEMIC TENURE AT EDINBURGH WAS MARKED BY EXCELLENCE. THE UNIVERSITY WAS RENOWNED FOR ITS RIGOROUS CURRICULUM IN ANATOMY, SURGERY, AND MEDICINE, WHICH BARRY EXCELLED IN, GRADUATING WITH A MEDICAL DEGREE IN 1812.
