IN SUM, FREE PRINTABLE READING ASSESSMENT TESTS REMAIN A FOUNDATIONAL RESOURCE WITHIN LITERACY EDUCATION. THEIR EASE OF USE, COST-EFFECTIVENESS, AND ADAPTABILITY CONTRIBUTE TO THEIR ONGOING RELEVANCE, ESPECIALLY WHEN COMBINED WITH PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT AND COMPLEMENTARY ASSESSMENT TOOLS.

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
