- **PUBLICATION DATE:** BEING PUBLISHED IN 2009, IT MAY NOT COVER THE VERY LATEST DEVELOPMENTS IN PHILOSOPHY, PARTICULARLY IN FIELDS LIKE COGNITIVE SCIENCE OR APPLIED ETHICS.
- **LENGTH:** THOUGH COMPREHENSIVE, THE 487 PAGES MIGHT BE DAUNTING FOR CASUAL READERS SEEKING A BRIEF OVERVIEW.
- **ACADEMIC TONE:** THE PROFESSIONAL AND ANALYTICAL STYLE MAY REQUIRE SUSTAINED FOCUS, WHICH MIGHT BE CHALLENGING FOR SOME NOVICE READERS.

DESPITE THESE, THE BOOK REMAINS A VALUABLE RESOURCE DUE TO ITS FOUNDATIONAL COVERAGE AND CLEAR EXPOSITION.
