WHEN HE AWAKENS, HE RETURNS TO HIS VILLAGE ONLY TO DISCOVER THAT EVERYTHING HAS CHANGED: HIS WIFE HAS PASSED AWAY, HIS CHILDREN ARE GROWN, AND THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION HAS RESHAPED THE LAND HE ONCE KNEW.

## THE SYMBOLISM OF RIP'S LONG SLEEP

RIP'S TWENTY-YEAR SLUMBER IS MORE THAN JUST A PLOT DEVICE—IT SYMBOLIZES THE PASSAGE OF TIME AND THE INEVITABILITY OF CHANGE. HIS SLEEP REPRESENTS A KIND OF SUSPENDED ANIMATION, WHERE THE WORLD MOVES ON WITHOUT HIM. ## IDENTITY AND BELONGING
