5. **HAJJ (PILGRIMAGE):** MAKING A PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY CITY OF MECCA AT LEAST ONCE IN A LIFETIME IF PHYSICALLY AND FINANCIALLY ABLE.

THESE PILLARS EMPHASIZE BOTH PERSONAL DEVOTION AND SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY, COMBINING SPIRITUAL GROWTH WITH ETHICAL LIVING.

THE QURAN AND HADITH: SOURCES OF GUIDANCE
