WHILE THE STUDY GUIDE EXCELS IN PRESENTING DIVERSE VOICES, CERTAIN LIMITATIONS MUST BE ACKNOWLEDGED. SURVIVOR TESTIMONIES, THOUGH INVALUABLE, ARE SUBJECT TO MEMORY DISTORTION AND PERSONAL BIAS, ESPECIALLY GIVEN THE

TRAUMATIC NATURE OF THE DISASTER. THE GUIDE TYPICALLY ADDRESSES THIS BY CROSS-REFERENCING ACCOUNTS AND INCORPORATING OFFICIAL INQUIRY FINDINGS TO PROVIDE BALANCED INTERPRETATIONS.

ADDITIONALLY, THE FOCUS ON ENGLISH-SPEAKING SURVIVORS MAY INADVERTENTLY MARGINALIZE VOICES FROM NON-ENGLISH PASSENGERS OR CREW, WHICH CAN AFFECT THE COMPREHENSIVENESS OF THE NARRATIVE. FUTURE EDITIONS OR SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS COULD BENEFIT FROM INCLUDING TRANSLATED TESTIMONIES OR INTERNATIONAL PERSPECTIVES TO ADDRESS THIS GAP.
